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ACADEMIC ADVISING NOTES:

- GWS, GHA, GQ, GN, GA, GH, and GS are codes used to identify General Education requirements.; Must complete at least 3 cr. of United States (US) and 3 cr. of International Cultures (IL).; W is the code used to designate courses that satisfy University Writing Across the Curriculum requirement.
- ETM notes a course is required for Entrance To Major / certification program.
- NOTE: Summer study could reduce some of the credit loads above. ****At least one "GN" selection must include a concurrent or subsequent lab.**
- The course series listed above is only one of many possible ways to move through this curriculum. Please be sure to also use the curriculum check-sheets and degree audits, as well as consult with an adviser about appropriate scheduling sequences, clearances for field experiences and PECT-PAPA testing requirements.

ENTRANCE TO THE MAJOR Fall Junior year/ Semester 5

NOTE: Brandywine transfers Community College courses with comparable competencies to PSU courses.

1. The College of Education (*even though you are staying at Brandywine*) begins the **review process early Spring Semester (Semester 4)**.
2. You will receive a College of Education letter mid-Spring semester regarding a review of your completion of requirements.
3. *Brandywine will work with candidates on a case-by-case basis through the Spring, Semester 4 & summer (between Semester 4 & 5) – meet with your advisor to **Petition for CONDITIONAL STATUS.***

Entrance-to-the-Major (ETM) requirements by the END of Semester 3 (Beg. Semester 4)

- A minimum cumulative grade point average (**GPA**) of **3.00**
- Qualifying score of 220 out of 300 score possible on EACH of the **Pennsylvania Educator Certification Tests (PECT), Pre-service Academic Performance Assessment (PAPA): Reading, Writing, & Mathematics.**
As of April 2, 2012, these tests will be required for Teacher Candidates in PA. (*These are similar to the ETS, PRAXIS tests – just different company. So DO GET the PECT & PAPA study guides.*) Online Information & registration: <http://www.pa.nesinc.com/>
- Documentation of at least **80 hours of volunteer or paid education work experience** with learners of the age group the candidate plans to teach (PreK – 4th grade).

Entrance-to-the-Major (ETM) requirements by the END of Semester 4 (Summer before Fall ETM may be considered to complete requirements)

- Completed with a grade of **“C” or better in all nine (9) ETM courses:** (*May still be completing coursework - SPRING, SEMESTER 4*)

- Completed least **48 semester credit hours**; but completion of all coursework for first four semesters is recommended
- Confirm your major / option** and campus through **eLion**
Step one (1): Log on to elion and in left navigation bar – click on “ENTRANCE TO MAJOR”. **Step one (2):** To Update, go to “PROCEED TO UPDATE A MAJOR PREFERENCE” (bottom on the page). List your FIRST Major choice (College of Ed., CEAED, PreK-4th) & CAMPUS choice (if staying at Brandywine OR another campus, i.e. Univ. Park); then also list your SECOND Major choice (just in case)
- Approval from the professional education adviser** / head of the pertinent certification program (Letter from U.Park College of Ed)
